Wraparound Care

Eligibility for 30 hours free funding will depend on meeting certain criteria. If one of the following is relevant to your circumstances you may be eligible but you will need to apply to HMRC to confirm this:

- all parents in the house earn at least the equivalent of 16 hours at national minimum wage and you don't earn over £100,000 per parent in your household
- 1 parent is employed and 1 parent is disabled or incapacitated, based on receipt of specific benefits
- 1 parent is employed and 1 parent has substantial caring responsibilities, based on specific benefits received for caring
- both parents are employed but 1 or both parents are temporarily away from the workplace on parental, maternity, paternity or adoption leave
- if both parents are employed but 1 or both parents are temporarily away from the workplace on statutory sick pay.
- Self-employed parents and parents on zero-hours contracts will be eligible if they meet the average earnings criteria.
