Nursery Curriculum Overview – Summer 2



This half term our topic is 'Colour'. We will be focussing on colour and patterns as we share some well-loved stories Elmer's Colours, Brown Bear, Brown Bear, My Mum and Dad Make me Laugh and Rainbow Fish.



Prime areas

This term the children will:

- Continue to be responsible for carrying out small tasks as 'Helper of the Day'.
- Demonstrate their understanding of how to transport and use tools safely both inside and outside of the classroom.
- Continue to negotiate and solve minor problems independently.
- Share and take turns when playing with their peers.
- Change into and out of their clothes when preparing for Forest School and P.E.
- Begin to hold writing implements correctly and use them to form recognisable letters not in their own name.

Literacy

Reading

Children will:

- Demonstrate their understanding that information can be found in books and on the internet.
- Begin to make predictions when sharing stories.
- Be able to identify letters by the sounds they make and begin to hear words when an adult blends two or three sounds together.
- Show an interest in print in the environment and recognise familiar signs and logos.
 Writing

Children will:

- Continue to take part in activities to develop fine motor control for holding writing implements correctly.
- Have the opportunity to make marks and give meaning to these marks as they draw, write and paint.
- Continue to learn the rhymes associated with the letters in their name to assist with forming these letters correctly.

Maths

Children will:

- Begin to use the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting.
- Begin to complete a simple repeated pattern and then make up some of their own.
- Attempt to represent numbers 0-5 and then to 10 and beyond.
- Begin to use everyday language related to time and money through Role Play.



Other information

<u>Forest school</u>: Will continue to take place on a Monday. Kit should now include a sun hat and sun cream should be applied prior to coming to school.

<u>P.E.</u> — Will take place on Tuesday. Jewellery should not be worn for this activity. Where earrings cannot be removed please provide medical tape which we will use to cover small studs only.

Please note: All clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name. Please remember that pen washes out so many items are now unnamed. We will happily assist when clothing is misplaced providing it was clearly labelled. Unfortunately, we will be unable to be as helpful if this is not the case.

<u>Library Days:</u> Tuesday — Blue group, Wednesday — Green group and Thursday —Red group. Please ensure your child's library book is in his/her book bag on these days as time is limited and we are unable to change books randomly throughout the week.

<u>Transition into reception:</u> All children who will be transferring into our reception classes will have the opportunity to visit these classrooms during the summer term, details to follow shortly.

Finally, if you are planning to take your child out of nursery before the end of term please inform a member of staff so that we have time to gather all of their belongings.
