Uniform and jewellery

If your child has pierced ears then they should only wear small studs which they can remove for PE. A wristwatch (not connected to smart devices) may also be worn, but other than this, jewellery is not allowed in school please.

We will however be trying once more and collecting Christmas jumpers again in the New Year which we will hold for next December when we hope to offer them for sale at a bargain price for school funds.
