| <p>Objectives of funding spend:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continue to improve and develop the provision of Physical Education (PE) and sports provision at Warren Primary School through the introduction of further sporting and Physical education opportunities</li><li>• Continue to embed the PE Scheme of work and CPD opportunities</li><li>• Ensure that PE &amp; Sports provision is judged as at least good by external monitoring</li><li>• Broaden the sporting opportunities and experiences available to pupils through new contacts of sport provision and competitions</li><li>• To develop a love of sport and physical activity for all pupils but in particular those who are less active outside of school</li><li>• To continue to implement the Daily Mile Initiative regularly</li><li>• To continue and develop Sport leader roles within the school</li><li>• To develop closer links to other Trust PE/sports departments and take advantage of the opportunities that may present themselves</li><li>• Develop gifted and talented provision</li><li>• To develop a wider range of team events throughout the school including for pupils who have special educational needs and/or disabilities</li><li>• Raise the awareness of the link between children's Mental Health and being physically active through PE lessons</li><li>• Focus on the children's mental health through close working partnership between the sports coach and counsellor</li><li>• Through Sports leadership opportunities, pupils to organise and implement sponsored events to raise funds to develop the sports provision further</li><li>• Develop annual In-house competitions to promote the enjoyment of exercise, sport and physical activity</li><li>• Look for opportunities to increase participation Develop an SEND sports event which may include other Trust schools</li></ul> |        |
